



State Virtual School Allotment Funding Available for TxVSN Summer Courses

- House Bill 3646 created a state virtual school allotment to fund courses provided through the TxVSN.
- The Commissioner is exercising the option to fund seats available for students in grades 9, 10, 11, or 12 during summer 2010.
- When a student successfully completes an online course provided through the TxVSN, the Texas Education Agency provides a payment of \$400 per semester course to the district providing the course and \$80 to the student's district.
- In order for students to participate in summer courses, districts and open enrollment charter schools must:
 - Complete the TxVSN District and Open Enrollment Charter Agreement and steps as outlined at www.txvsn.org.
 - Provide the on-going support necessary to maximize probability that the student will successfully complete the course
- Summer school enrollment opens Monday, March 8, 2010, beginning with districts with an ADA of 10,000 or fewer students, and continues each subsequent day based on district size.
