Wherever and whenever you study, you'll find that your teacher -- or *magister* -- is always visible, thanks to extensive use of streaming video.

For example, your magister uses screencasts to present and explain the lesson you're studying. Some are presented in a formal classroom setting; others, in a variety of interesting locations.

The lessons include links to many video resources, in some cases to add even more depth to the material; in others, just to add some fun.

Your magister will also schedule Live Classroom sessions. In these, you'll get together with your teacher and classmates around the state in live, online sessions. You'll communicate *in real time* using voice, texting and your webcam. It's almost like being in a traditional classroom, and creates the same sense of community.

This same tool also effectively serves as your magister's online office. It allows you to reach your teacher, individually or in groups, whenever you need extra help -- when prepping for a test, for example.

Your assignments will include a number of

opportunities to collaborate with your classmates ... for example, writing and performing a skit based on one of the stories you'll study.

In these, you'll use online wikis to plan your project.

You'll also participate in online forums, in which you and your fellow students respond to questions and topics posted by your teacher.

Other assignments will involve posting reflections to your own public blog and private journal.

The course includes many other activities created to make learning Latin interesting and fun. For example, one turns a vocabulary drill into a game of Hangman. Another tests your understanding with a crossword puzzle.

All of these activities -- in fact, the whole course structure -- are explained in the video Orientation and outlined in the course Syllabus document.

There is much more to tell you about this course, and the fun you'll have taking it, but we hope you've gotten the idea: that Latin is alive and well -- and *relevant* -- in today's world.
